### **Rise and Shine**

Two eggs any style, hash browns and choice of 2 sausages or 2 pieces of bacon with toast or biscuit and gravy. \$6.75.

### **Hillbilly Breakfast**

Country Ham steak or Country Fried Steak with two biscuits and gravy, hash browns and 2 eggs any style. \$8.75

### **Cave Country Feast**

Three eggs any style, hash browns, 3 flapjacks and choice of 3 sausages or bacon, with toast or biscuits and gravy. \$9.95

### **Plateau Omelet**

Three egg omelet made your way with any combination of: cheese, sausage, bacon, onion, bell pepper, tomato, turkey, or ham, with toast or biscuits and gravy. \$7.25

### **Flapjacks**

**Short Stack:** 2 buttermilk pancakes & 2 sausages or bacon. \$5.95

**Gonzo Stack:** 4 buttermilk pancakes & 2 sausages or bacon. \$7.25

**Winning Colors was the third and last filly to win the Kentucky Derby.** After winning both of her starts as a 2-year-old, the roan daughter of Caro defeated her class in the Santa Anita Oaks and then trounced males in the Santa Anita Derby by 7 1/2 length. In the 1988 Kentucky Derby, jockey Gary Stevens sent her to the front as was her usual style, and led every step of the way, holding off the late rally of Forty Niner by a neck for the hard-fought victory. It was the first Derby win for both Stevens and trainer D. Wayne Lukas. She completed the Triple Crown series with a third in the Preakness and then sixth in the Belmont.



She retired with 8 wins, 3 seconds, and 1 third in 19 starts, earning \$1,526,837 for owner Eugene Klein. **In 2000, she was elected to the National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame at Saratoga Springs.**
